

# **The AI Robot Future**


Everything is going to change in the future. Some say it will be the monumental change in history.

## AI Robot Future?


What will that Future Look Like?

## AI's Impact

- Will displace Knowledge Workers
- 20-40% will lose their jobs by 2030
- \$20 to \$200/mo/person for AI
- Replaced by people who know how to use AI to be more productive

Let's talk first about AI's impact on jobs.

It's predicted that AI will displace around 20 to 40% of knowledge workers by 2030. They'll be replaced by an AI system that will only cost between \$20 and \$200 dollars per month

First they will be replaced by people who know how to use AI. Then eventually completely replaced by AI.

## Robot's Impact

- Will displace Manual Laborers
- 20-47% will lose their jobs by 2030
- \$20K/30K robot replaces \$50K worker
- Upskilling will be more difficult for these people



Now onto the impact of robots. Robots will be produced in the millions, maybe even billions. They will displace manual laborers. It's projected that between 20 and 47% will lose their jobs to robots. And those robots will only cost between 20 & \$30,000 and work 3 shifts a day for around 5 years. You can see how the economics work out. And upskilling will be even harder for these workers.


## The Lost
